The 2016 Spirit of Service Scholarship Awards

The Spirit of Service Scholarship Awards program, formerly known as The Syl Bartos Scholarship, was established to provide a modest scholarship award to one or more high school seniors currently serving Blumenthal Performing Arts as a Junior Ambassador. The purpose of the scholarship fund is to encourage the pursuit of higher education and provide financial assistance for expenses related to the first year of college. This assistance reinforces Blumenthal's commitment to provide unique opportunities for high school juniors and seniors through the Junior Ambassadors Program.

For more than a decade this scholarship solely honored Syl Bartos, BPA's very first House Manager and a tremendous supporter of the Junior Ambassadors program. The name of the scholarship awards program was recently changed to recognize the unselfish efforts and gifts of additional individuals devoted to supporting the educational mission of Blumenthal Performing Arts.

Scholarship Application Criteria and Process

- Must be a high school senior currently serving as a BPA Junior Ambassador
- Must have ushered a minimum of 14 BPA events
- Must have attended a minimum of three Junior Ambassador seminars
- Must have a minimum 3.3 high school GPA (cumulative)
- Must submit a copy of most recently available grades transcript
- Must submit a copy of most recent FAFSA report
- Must submit a double-space, one-to-two-page essay addressing the following questions:
 - 1) What have you learned through your experience as a Junior Ambassador?
 - 2) What are your college plans? (Please include the names of colleges/universities that have accepted you and/or the school you have chosen.)
 - 3) As of now, what are your post-college goals?
- The completed essay, grades transcript and FAFSA report must be received by Blumenthal Performing Art's Education Department <u>no later than April</u> 7, <u>2016</u>.
